



# Blessed John Paul II and St. Padre Pio Stained Glass Window Family Activity

**SUPPLIES:** SCISSORS, COLORFUL TISSUE PAPER, GLUE,(SLIGHTLY WATERED DOWN AND IN A SMALL BOWL), INEXPENSIVE PICTURE FRAME WITH GLASS (FOUND AT DOLLARTREE OR WALMART), COLORING PAGE OF BLESSED POPE JOHN PAUL II OR ST. PADRE PIO, AND CRAYONS.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. USE CRAYONS TO BRIGHTLY COLOR THE COLORING PAGE YOU WANT TO USE.
2. REMOVE THE CARDBOARD BACKING OF THE PICTURE FRAME. PUT GLUE ON THE GLASS FROM THE INSIDE OF THE PICTURE FRAME. SECURE GLASS WITHIN THE FRAME BY FOLDING OVER THE SMALL METAL TABS. SOME INEXPENSIVE FRAMES GLUE THE GLASS TO THE FRAME SO THIS IS NOT NECESSARY.
3. CUT OUT THE COLORED IMAGE SO THAT IT IS SMALLER THAN THE SIZE OF YOUR PICTURE FRAME. IT CAN BE SQUARE OR OVAL OR A FANCY SHAPE LIKE THE PICTURE OF THE NATIVITY BELOW. PLACE IN FACE DOWN ON THE GLASS CENTERING AND PRESSING IT INTO THE GLUE.
4. CUT-UP PIECES OF THE TISSUE PAPER INTO SMALL GEOMETRIC SHAPES AND THEN ARRANGE THEM ON TOP OF THE GLASS IN THE EMPTY AREAS.
1. LET DRY. HANG IN A WINDOW OR BRIGHT PLACE TO LET THE LIGHT THROUGH. ENJOY!
