

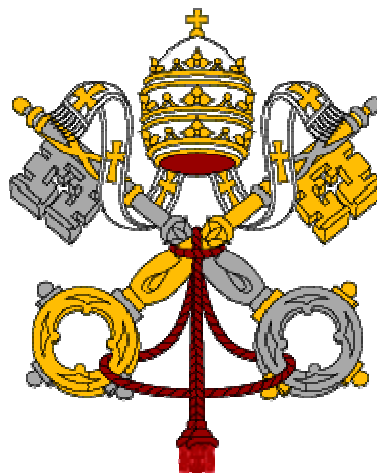
The Papacy

The Papal Coat of Arms

- the papal tiara (as used under the pontificate of Pius XI) with its three tiers: *order, jurisdiction, and magisterium*
- the two keys represent the keys to Heaven (according to the Gospel of Matthew 16:19) given by Jesus Christ to St. Peter. The popes are regarded as the successor of Peter, and the gold and silver keys have been significant elements in the symbolism of the Papal State since the 13th century. The gold represents spiritual power, while the silver key represents worldly power.
- a red cord connects the keys representing the bond between the two powers
